

The Discipleship Cycle Diagram Explained

Turn to **Matthew 28:18-20**, read aloud, and discuss.

Point 1 - On the blank inside the box, answer the following question: What is the first step involved in the process of making disciples?

Point 2 - On the blank inside the box, answer the following question: After someone has been evangelizing and eventually leads a person to believe Christ, what is the next step involved in the process of making disciples?

Point 3 - On the blank inside the box, answer the following question: Once this person has been baptized in light of his or her commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ, what is the next step involved in the process of making disciples?

Point 4 - On the blank inside the box, answer the following question: Now that this person has been lead to faith in Christ, baptized in light of this commitment, and has been taught and equipped to obey the commands of the Lord Jesus, including the mandate to minister the gospel to others, what is the next step involved in the process of making disciples?

Point 5

- a) Whereas there was first only one person making disciples, now there are two.
- b) Discuss the importance of making disciples that are able to spiritually reproduce.
- c) Discuss the cyclical nature of the continuing process of making disciples.
